Locate Additional Books

Search the University of Texas Libraries online Library Catalog (utdirect.utexas.edu/lib/utnetcat) to locate additional materials. If you know the name of a campus architect, try a Subject or Author search under the architect's name (last name first). Also search the following Library of Congress subject headings in a Subject Search:

Search Indexes to Periodical Articles

Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals, 1860-. Go to *Databases & Indexes to Articles* at www.lib.utexas.edu/indexes/ and browse the alphabetical listing under 'A' to select the *Avery Index* (off campus access is limited to U.T. Austin users). The *Avery Index* helps you locate architecture articles published since 1860. Search "*university texas austin buildings*" or the name of an architect as Subject Keywords. Once you have gathered a list of articles, use the yellow "Find it @ UT" button next to each citation to search for a paper or electronic copy in the University of Texas Libraries. If the article is in a journal that is not held by the libraries, U.T. Austin borrowers can request a copy through Interlibrary Loan at www.lib.utexas.edu/services/ils/.

Austin American-Statesman Archives. Go to www.archives.statesman.com.

Allows keyword searching of full text of articles since 1989. (The Austin History Center maintains a paper index to earlier years). CAH has this title on microfilm for 1987-1999, PCL has microfilm for 2000 to the present.
