## SELECTS ITS OFFICERS.

### W. O. Brown Company Awaiting Plans for Greater Building of Brick, Stone and Steel.

Announcement is made that the new building for the W. O. Brown Company is to be larger than was at first intended. It is now planned to have a basement two-thirds above the ground and four stories above the basement. The building on the corner of Main and Broadway streets will be 100 feet square and is to be of steel, brick and stone.

Building operations are to begin as soon as the plans, now being drafted by **Hubbell** and **Greene** have been completed and approved. The plant will be the warehouse and factory of the buggy company.
