

MASONIC CATHEDRAL READY FOR REUNION

OFFICIAL SCHEDULE ANNOUNCED FOR SCOTTISH RITE MEETING.

Workmen on Building Are Anxious to View Interior of Structure After Its Completion.

The official schedule for the Scottish Rite reunion, which will begin Monday and continue until Friday, inclusive, was announced yesterday. The program calls for a very active session, the chief feature of which will be the dedication of the magnificent Scottish Rite Cathedral, which will be held Friday.

The luncheons, which will intersperse the active sessions of the Rite, will be served in the basement by the ladies of the East-Dallas Christian Church.

Herbert M. Greene, architect for the building, announces that all of those who have been engaged in the work of finishing and decorating the interior have been very much interested in the big task of completing it prior to the reunion. The work will be completed tonight.

Workmen Are Interested.

"Every workman, including the women who have made the draperies and tapestries, as well as those of every other craft, is very much interested in the building," Mr. Greene said. "They have formed some idea of the great beauty of the building and have expressed a desire to see it after it had been completely finished.

"I expect to recommend to the directors of the Scottish Rite Association that after the reunion is over these people who have been engaged in the work of completing and decorating the building be permitted to inspect it on some night to be specially designated and hear the great organ when the building is illuminated."
