

HELLA TEMPLE HOSPITAL PLANS ARE SUBMITTED.

At a meeting of Hella Temple crippled children's hospital committee in the office of Sam P. Cochran Saturday afternoon plans for the building were submitted. The building specifications were turned over to Herbert M. Greene Company for the purpose of developing working plans, after which bids will be called for on the construction of the hospital.
