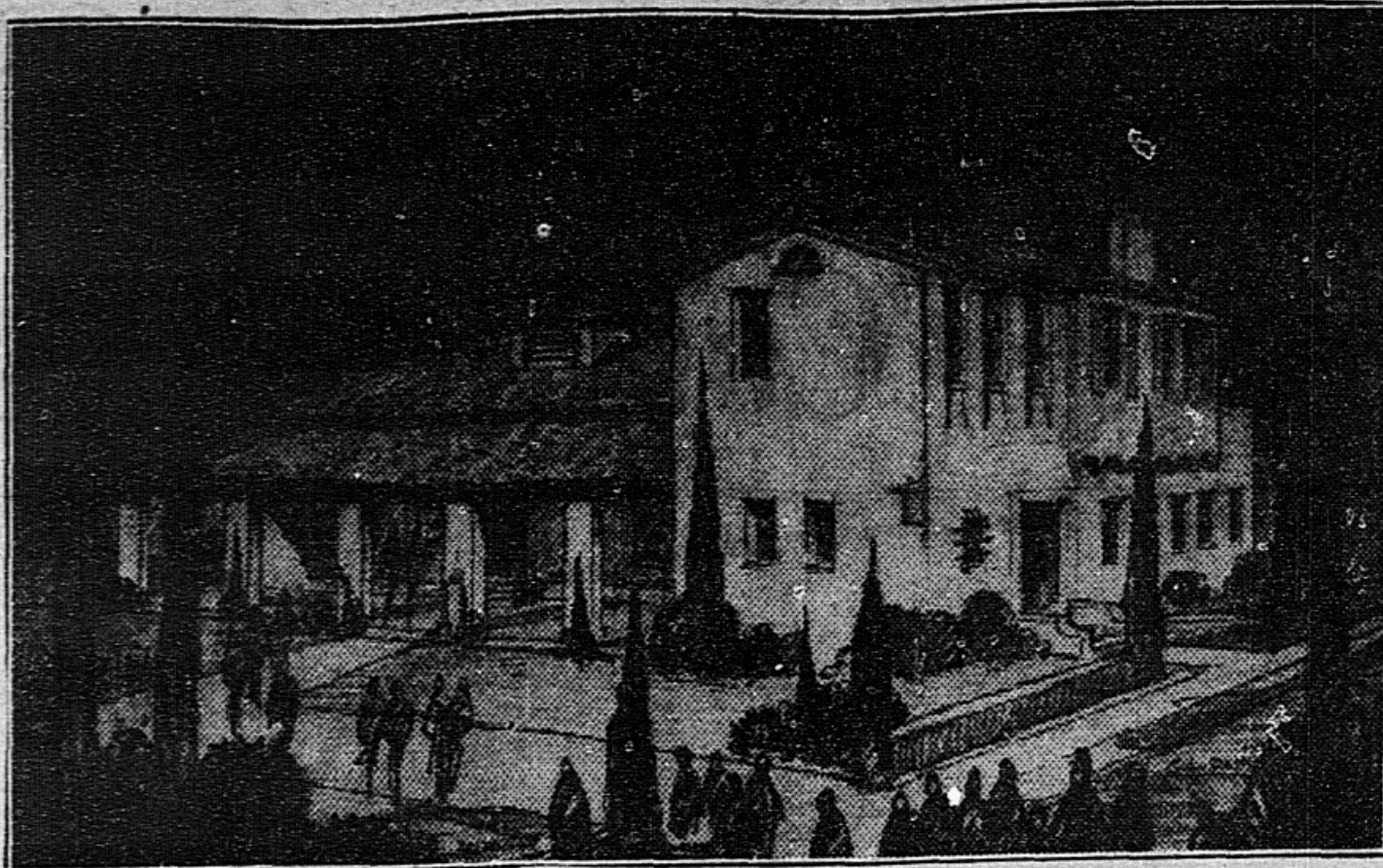

Building Restaurant With Garden Effect



Construction work on the King Virginia Gardens on the site of the old open-air theater of Cycle Park at Second avenue and Gunter street, East Dallas, is nearing completion and the building will be opened Oct. 1. T. C. Lupton, own-

er, said Saturday. The same garden effect that was characteristic of the old theater will be continued in the grounds of the restaurant.

The building is stuccoed in soft pastel shades and covered with a tile roofing. It will be surrounded with shrubs, bushes and bridges,

giving a distinctive European garden appearance.

Mr. Lupton employed as architects the Herbert M. **Greene** Company, consisting of Herbert M. **Greene**, William Brown Fowler, E. Bruce **LaRoche** and George L. **Dahl**.
