# Six Buildings Distinguished By Architects

**New and Remodeled Jobs Judged by Committee From Chapter.**

**Plaques Awarded**

**Plates to Be Placed on Structures to Show Distinction.**

Six Dallas buildings, either newly constructed or remodeled within the eighteen months ended Dec. 31, were found worthy of praise for their design by the North Texas Chapter, American Institute of Architects, in a report of a special committee of the institute made to the Retail Mer-

chants' Association and given to the public Wednesday.

The two buildings found especially worthy of mention and for which prizes were awarded in the form of bronze plaques to be placed on the buildings were the six-story building of Dreyfuss & Sons at Main and Ervay streets, a new structure, and the ten-story W. A. Green Company building at 1616 Elm street, a re-modeled structure.

Four other new buildings were given honorable mention, these being
