

# ***Film and Cinema Information***

Film and cinema information can be found in both print and electronic sources available in the Undergraduate Library. ## **General Information**

### ***Leonard Maltin's Movie and Video Guide***

PN 1992.8 F5 M3 2001

Concise guide to over 20,000 films. Includes date, ratings, partial cast listing, and a brief summary.

### ***International Motion Picture Almanac***

PN 1993.3 I55 2001

Includes film statistics, brief biographies, synopses of recent films and directories of production services worldwide.

### ***Dictionary of Film Quotations***

PN 1994.9 C67 1995

Gives notable quotations from famous movies, arranged alphabetically by movie, with actor and subject indexes.

### ***The Complete Film Dictionary***

PN 1993.45 K66 1997

Covers all aspects of filmmaking, including definitions of technical terms, expressions used in movie making, business jargon, historical terminology, film criticism, and theory terms. Highlights recent technological developments.

### ***The Film Encyclopedia***

PN 1993.45 K34 1994

One-volume international encyclopedia with biographies and filmographies of actors, directors, producers, and others involved in filmmaking. Other entries include styles and genres of filmmaking, technical terminology, and studio information.

## **Reviews – Print Indexes**

### ***Film Review Annual***

PN 1993 F5475

Provides full-text reviews with an index at the end of each volume that is searchable by title, film critic, producer, cast, music, director and screenwriters. Movies are organized alphabetically by film title.

### ***The New York Times Film Reviews***

PN 1995 N4

Reprints the film reviews that appeared in *The New York Times*. For the years 1913 to 1968, see the index in volume 6. From 1969 to the present, see the index in each volume.

### ***Magill's Cinema Annual***

PN 1993.3 M34

Includes entries for the major films of each year, including a review and summary, partial credits, taglines and quotes, and box office gross for each film. Also contains awards and obituaries for the year.

## Reviews - Online Indexes

The following library indexes include reviews of movies from magazines and newspapers. Indexes can be located through UT Library Online <http://www.lib.utexas.edu> under "Databases and Indexes to Articles." Some of the articles in these indexes may be in full text. If not, locate them in the library by searching by the name of the journal in UtnetCAT Library Catalog <http://dpweb1.dp.utexas.edu/lib/utnetcat/>.

### ***Expanded Academic ASAP***

Contains reviews from both popular and scholarly publications.

TIP: Type the title of the film followed by "AND reviews" in the search box.

#### **Subject guide search**

Click in the entry box and enter search term(s)

Browse listing of subjects, people, products, locations and organizations that contain words you entered

### ***International Index to the Performing Arts (IIPA)***

Contains articles from over 200 scholarly and popular performing arts periodicals. Go to the search page and enter the title of the film in the "All Keywords" box.

TIP: Only some articles are available in full text. Others can be found in UtnetCAT by searching for the name of the journal.

### ***MLA Bibliography***

1. Type the name of the film in the search box.
2. Make sure the "Map Term to Subject Heading" box is checked.
3. Select the film title on the subject heading page and click continue.
4. Click "display" in the search history to see your results.
