

## **HISTORICAL NEWSPAPER ARCHIVES:**

- [African American Newspapers](#) (1827-1902): Full text access to the major African-American newspapers published in the United States during the 19th century.
- [America's Historical Newspapers](#) (1690-1922): More than 1,000 U.S. historical newspapers from all 50 states. Search by dates, eras, article types (news & opinion, election returns, advertisements, etc.), region/state, and newspaper name.
- [Dallas Morning News Archive](#) (1885 - 1977): Digital reproduction of every article, advertisements, photos and graphics. Keyword searches can be limited by date or document type (editorial, comic, obituary, etc.).
- [Hispanic American Newspapers](#) (1808 - 1980): Large archive of Spanish-language and bilingual Spanish/English newspapers printed in the U.S. during the 19th and 20th centuries.
- [Los Angeles Times](#) (1881 - 1985): Digital reproductions of every page, every article, advertisements, photos and graphics. Keyword searches can be limited by date, author or document type (editorial, comic, obituary, etc.).
- [New York Times](#) (1851 - 2004): Digital reproductions of every page, every article, advertisements, photos and graphics. Keyword searches can be limited by date, author or document type (editorial, comic, obituary, etc.).
- [Nineteenth Century US Newspapers](#) (1800 - 1900): 500 U.S. newspapers, covering a broad geographical and chronological range. Searches can be restricted by categories (such as, Advertising, Business News, Images, Editorials, etc.), by states & cities, and by date of publication.
- [Times Digital Archive](#) (1785 - 1985): Digital reproductions of every page, every article, advertisements, photos and graphics. Allows searching by date, author or section/category (editorial, comic, obituary, etc.).
- [Washington Post](#) (1877 - 1990): Digital reproductions of every page, every article, advertisements, photos and graphics. Keyword searches can be limited by date, author or document type (editorial, comic, obituary, etc.).

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
