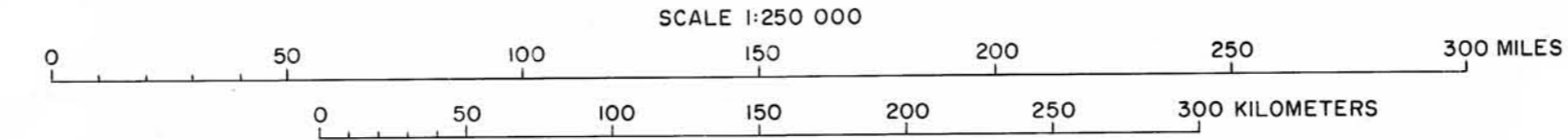

All trails except those of Capt. Pike and Majors
Fowler and Long, and the Texas trail were
plotted from Army Map Service aerial photographs.
Trails in southeastern part of area are obliterated
by plowing and dune sand. Parts of trails else-
where also are obliterated or are too faint to
show on high-altitude photographs.
Early towns are approximately located; dates of
founding also are approximate.
